Personal Biography*

Ibrahim Elgabrowny is a 59 year old man of Egyptian descent. He resided in Brooklyn prior to his arrest and was a self employed carpenter.

Brief Details about His Case

Ibrahim Elgabrowny was 45 when he was convicted of seditious conspiracy; assault of a Federal agent and city police detective seeking to search his home after the World Trade Centre bombing in 1993; possession of false identification documents and false passports. An Egyptian immigrant and cousin of Mr. Nosair, he was accused of being Mr. Nosair's "eyes and ears on the outside" after he was imprisoned in the Kahane case. He is expected to be released on 12/25/2021.

Why Should I Adopt Ibrahim?

Ibrahim is your Muslim brother who has been falsely accused of allegations. He did not commit any crime. He desperately needs letters from the Ummah to let him know that we are there supporting the brother in the difficulties he faces. He would really appreciate some mail reassuring him and the other brothers with him of this. He has been in prison for a long time and still has quite a bit to go before he is released. Let Ibrahim know that you are praying for him and haven't forgotten he exists.
